This new company, based in Sheffield, gathers great creative momentum from several successful dance/theatre collaborations in recent months, between Artistic Director Charlotte Vincent, and Movement Director Gregory Nash, Composer Dean Honer, and Dancer Harry Theaker.

VINCENT DANCE THEATRE creates political dancework, which grips, provokes and enchants both audience and performer alike. 'INTERCOURSE' is a violent, intimate duet for two athletic performers. This new work is an intense, layered piece which lashes out (with exhilarating contact improvisation, projected visual images and fearless solo work) at the decaying societal rules our generation has inherited. Emotionally charged, and forging compulsive physicality with subtle, contemporary reflection, 'INTERCOURSE' is highly personalised physical theatre.

'INTERCOURSE' tours nationally from late Autumn 1994 (November 4th) and throughout the Spring 1995 Season, and is now available for booking into the dance programme at your venue.
