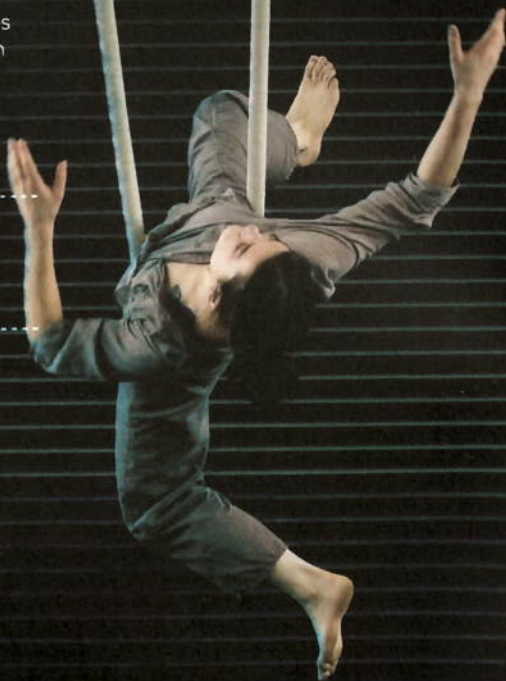
MATILDA LEYSER (UK) LINE, POINT, PLANE
