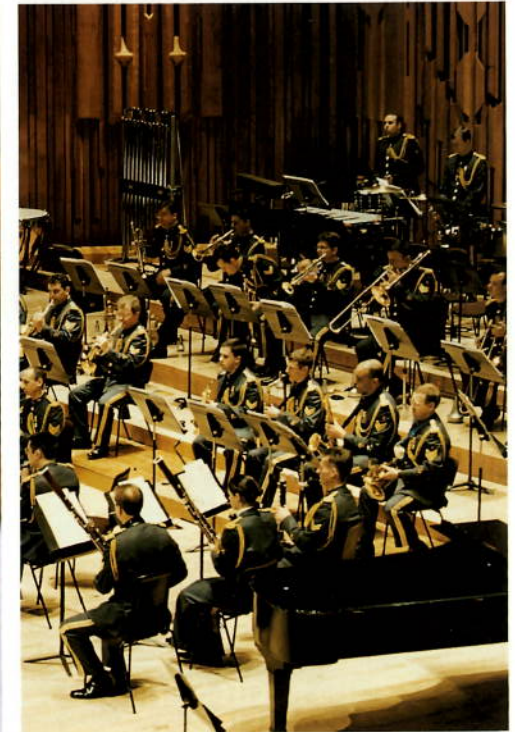

**CENTRAL BAND OF THE ROYAL AIR FORCE****The Band plays by permission of the Air Force Board of the Defence Council**

Music has been part of the Royal Air Force since 1912 when the service existed as the Royal Flying Corps. In 1922, the Central Band became the first military band to broadcast live on BBC radio, remaining to this day the most frequently featured military band on that medium. Over the years, the band has made many recordings: *Salute to Heroes* released in 1990 sold over 60,000 copies in two years and two complementary recordings - *Heroes of the Air* and *Salute to the Royal Air Force* have proved just as popular.
