Hold Tight is a new inter-generational ensemble production which reflects on the themes of enforced separation and insecurity to draw parallels between the impact of the global pandemic on family relationships and the effects adverse childhood experiences have on young lives.

Layered with psychological and emotional tension, with a beautiful soundtrack by Jules Maxwell, Hold Tight is performed by established Vincent Dance Theatre collaborators, including Rob Clark, Janusz Orlik, Aurora Lubos and Antonia Grove.
